- 3. Data about weed location and treatment may be included in a weed database for regional weed mapping and scientific analysis.
- 4. West Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District and its agents agree to hold landowner(s) harmless for all claims, suits or actions of whatsoever nature resulting from this cooperative agreement.
- 5. The permission granted by this agreement shall be continuing for five years unless revoked by the landowner(s) either orally or in writing.
