The purpose of this document is to authorize employees of West Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District or its agents/partners to enter or cross private property to conduct restoration and noxious weed removal activities (see section 1 below) and to absolve landowners from all liabilities related to actions conducted by West Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District or its agents.

1. This agreement is entered into to accomplish the following tasks:
  - Determine if target weeds (e.g. spurge laurel) are present and measure their extent.
  - Facilitate target weed control.
  - Provide access to site.
  - Allow project monitoring.
2. The work will occur on lands in Multnomah County, Oregon owned by the landowner at the above address.
3. Data about weed location and treatment may be included in a weed database for regional weed mapping and scientific analysis.
4. West Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District and its agents agree to hold landowners harmless for all claims, suits or actions of whatsoever nature resulting from this cooperative agreement.
5. Permission is granted for up to 5 years or until formally revoked, either orally or in writing.
6. This agreement shall be effective upon the signature of the party listed below.
