This agreement authorizes employees of West Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District (WMSWCD) or its agents/partners to enter or cross private property to conduct restoration and noxious weed removal activities and absolves landowners from all liabilities related to actions conducted by WMSWCD or its agents.

1. This agreement permits the following tasks:
  - Determine if target weeds (e.g. garlic mustard) are present and measure the extent of infestation.
  - Facilitate target weed control.
  - Provide access to site and allow project monitoring.
2. The work will occur on lands in Multnomah County, Oregon owned by the landowner at the above address.
3. Data about weed location and treatment may be included in a weed database for regional weed mapping and scientific analysis.
4. West Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District and its agents agree to hold landowner(s) harmless for all claims, suits or actions of whatsoever nature resulting from this cooperative agreement.
5. The permission granted by this agreement shall be continuing unless revoked by the landowner(s) either orally or in writing.
6. This agreement shall be effective upon the signature of the party listed below.
